Gliwice [gli'viʦɛ] is a city in Upper Silesia, southern Poland, near Katowice. Gliwice is the west district of the Upper Silesian Metropolitan Union – a metropolis with a population of 2 million. The city is located in the Silesian Highlands, on the Kłodnica river (a tributary of the Oder).

Gliwice is one of the cities of a 2.7 million conurbation known as the Katowice urban area and is within the largest Silesian metropolitan area, which has a population of about 5,294,000 people. The population of the city is 185,196 (March 2014). It occupies the surface area of 134,2 km²

Over the past years Gliwice has become one of the most modern cities of Upper Silesia. Its strengths are its favourable location, advanced economy, comprehensive development of science and education, as well as rich cultural, sports and recreation life.
